With over 14 years in education, Jennifer has dedicated her career to assisting children with learning and behaviour challenges. Her multifaceted experience covers therapy, training and teaching, and early child development, including:

- Over a decade of experience in individualised evaluation and tailored therapeutic plans for children and young adults, with delivery of programmes both nationally and internationally.
- Over 50 workshops, training and teaching events, together with numerous community information lectures, delivered nationally and internationally, including on behalf of the South African Departments of Basic Education and Higher Education and Training, and with HPCSA (Health Professions Council of South Africa) and SACE (South African Council of Educators) accreditation awarded to select courses.
- Founded the Mindstretch Preschool for mild to moderately challenged learners in 2014 with the ultimate aim of facilitating 'inclusive education'. Previously, founded Funda Fun, a movement-based extramural playgroup, in 2002.

Jennifer works therapeutically with children and young adults presenting with learning and behaviour challenges, including ADD, ADHD, autism, Down syndrome, dyslexia and cerebral palsy, among others. She has a special interest in assisting children presenting with autism and autism spectrum disorders.

2014: Principal and Director of Mindstretch Preschool for children with mild to moderate learning challenges, including autism.

- Mindstretch Preschool was initiated in January 2014 with the objective of providing a nurturing environment for pre-schoolers with special learning needs, preparing to equip them for 'inclusive education'

2013: SACE-accredited educator's workshop on "Overcoming Barriers to Learning", with numerous additional seminars and workshops delivered for schools and educators, including Autism South Africa and SAGSA (South African Girls' Schools Association).

2013: Introduced Mindstretch to the Mauritian Ministry of Education; included delivering therapy to autistic learners in Mauritius.

2013: Initiated and implemented a support project for hearing impaired students at the King Sabata Dalindyebo FET (Further Education and Training) College, Eastern Cape.

2012: Trained and mentored over 60 nurses and carers at the Woodside Special Needs Centre, Cape Town.

2011: Designed, initiated and facilitated training for the Eden/Klein Karoo Education District.

2010: Developed a "Cognitive Screening Tool" for application at FET Colleges; the Tool provides an accessible test to help guide new students in selecting appropriate vocational studies.

2009-2010: Extensive programme of work conceived and delivered for the Western Cape Education Department. A 2010 special initiative involved assisting Metropole South Education District in introducing HANDLE into all their full service schools.
