



How the Right Music Helps Children with ASD


We've found some of our learners respond to music, specifically related to what's known as the 'Mozart effect'.

It's not for every child, but for some children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), **music can make a tremendous difference**.

What is the 'Mozart Effect'?

Mozart's music often gets attention because it features **clear**, **predictable patterns**, **gentle harmonies**, **and melodies** that create a soothing and structured environment.

<u>Studies</u> suggest these qualities can help children with ASD feel calmer and more comfortable, potentially easing anxiety and sensory overload.



It's About Musical Style, Not Just the Composer

While Mozart's music is often recommended, it's not the only option. Many pieces by composers such as Bach and Vivaldi, and various gentle contemporary works, share the same beneficial qualities.

Here's what to look for:

- **Structured melody:** Songs with clear, repetitive patterns.
- Calm harmonies: Gentle, non-abrasive sounds.
- Consistent pace: Avoiding sudden or chaotic musical changes.

Music therapy specialists stress that it's not about the composer's reputation, but about how musical elements match each child's unique sensory profile.

• Calming effect: Reduces anxiety and helps regulate mood.


- Sensory integration: Eases overwhelming auditory experiences.
